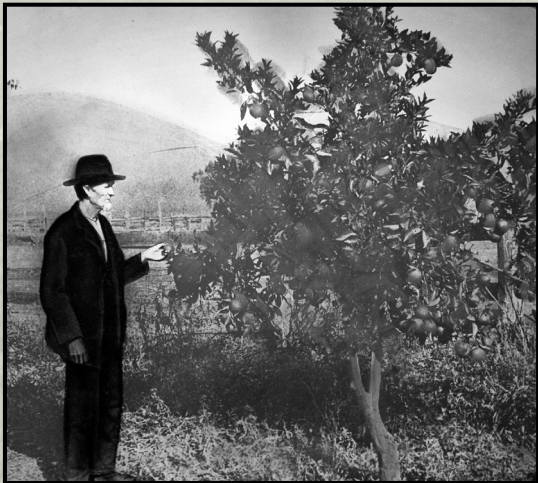
# *Rooted in Tradition...*

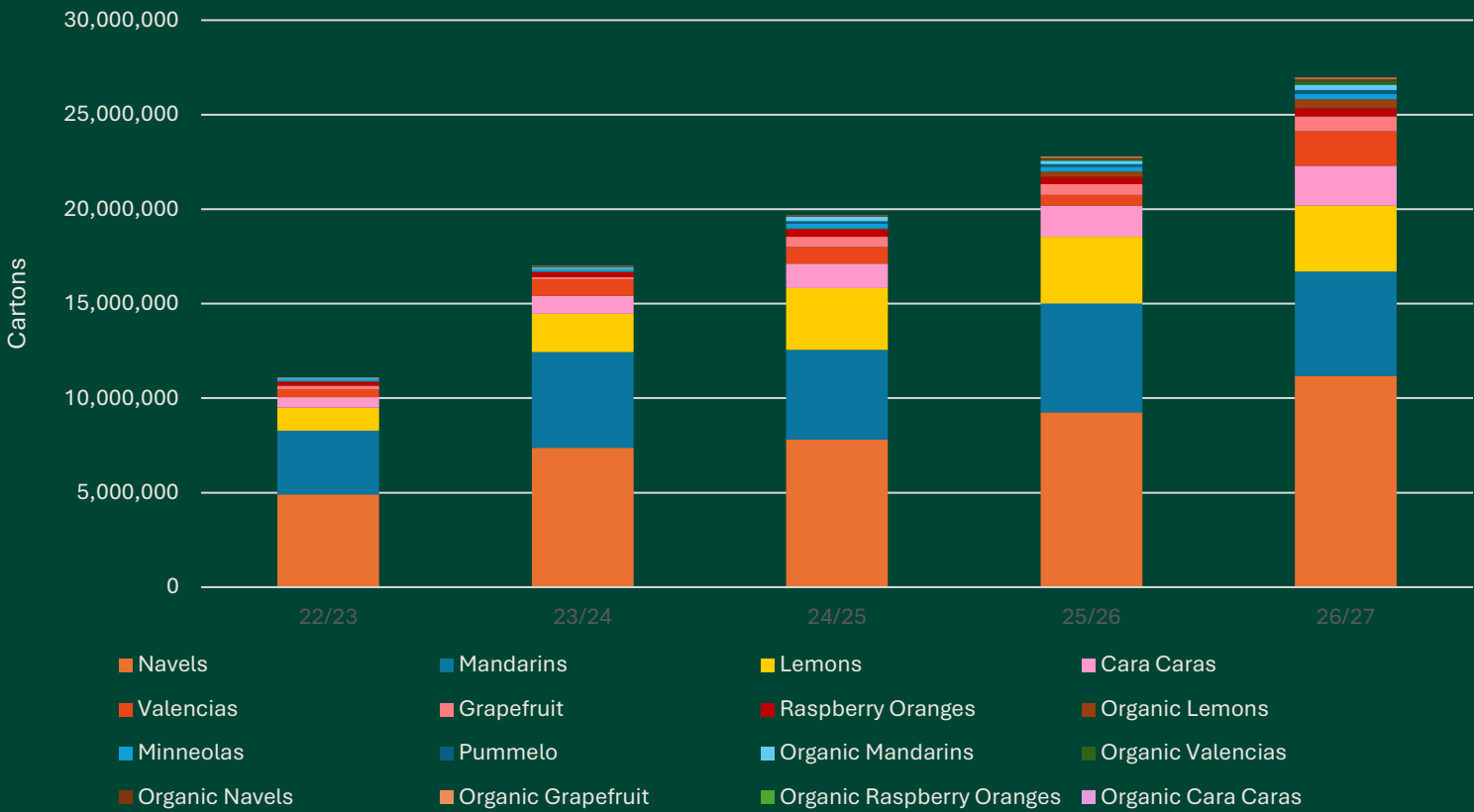

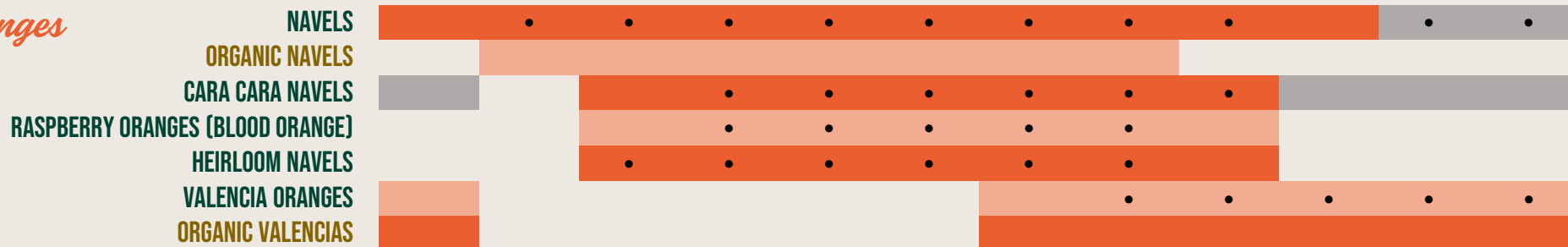

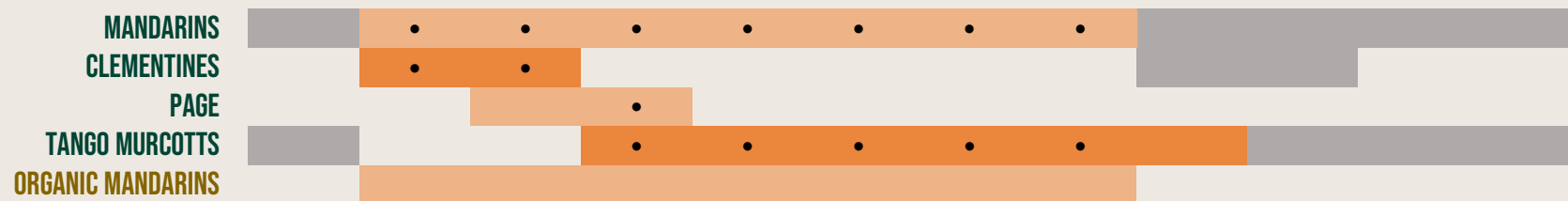

# *Social Responsibility*

KINGS RIVER PACKING STRIVES TO MAXIMIZE ITS PRODUCTION WHILE MINIMIZING THE IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT



## **WATER**

The Kings River is fed each year when the annual snowpack melts. It not only supplies surface water for irrigation and recreational use, but also recharges the water table shared by agriculture and local municipalities. Our growers use low volume irrigation systems to deliver water directly to the root zone in an efficient and controlled manner.



## **INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT**

Kings River Packing seeks to minimize the impact on the environment by using biologically based pest management systems, when possible, to encourage natural control of invasive insects. In order to remain at the forefront, we continue to develop and improve our pest management practices.



## **ORCHARD AND NUTRITION**

When essential nutrients are not available naturally, fertilizers must be applied to supplement the needs of the crop. Nutritional management is now a common practice in the citrus industry. The goal is to provide the trees with the nutrients necessary in a way that is efficient without compromising the environment.



## **SOLAR AND RECYCLING**

In keeping with environmentally friendly and ecologically responsible business practices at Kings River Packing, a large-scale cardboard recycling program and the installation of a megawatt solar power grid have been implemented.
